TOPIC WIGICC RECAP TRISH NAU

THE COUNCIL IS PUTTING TOGETHER A REPORT OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO GET SUPPORT FROM THE NETWORK IN SEEKING PERMANENCY. THEY ARE RE-LOOKING AT THE REPRESENTATION, BY-LAWS, AND VOTING IN PROCESS OF COUNCIL MEMBERS. THE GIO IS MOVING FORWARD ON THE STATE-WIDE PARCELS DATA PROJECT AND HOPES TO GET THE SUPPORT FROM THE GEOSPATIAL COMMUNITY ON DATA SHARING EFFORTS. THE MCD-COMMITTEE "COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE" WILL BE HAVING ANOTHER MEETING TO DISCUSS THEIR EFFORTS IN A STATE-WIDE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY LAYER.

TOPIC WLIA REGIONAL CONFERENCE RECAP ANDY HESS

ANDY REPORTED THAT OVERALL MEMBERSHIP WAS DOWN BUT STILL HAD A GOOD TURN OUT FOR THE CONFERENCE. THE WLIA BOARD IS LOOKING INTO POSSIBLY WEBCASTING THE REGIONAL MEETINGS FOR THOSE MEMBERS WHO ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND. THE 6 MAIN TOPICS COVERED AT THE MEETING THAT WERE VOTED IN LEVEL OF IMPORTANCE WERE: 1. STATE-WIDE DATASETS AND STANDARDIZATION 2. BRANDING: ROI, EFFICIENCIES, PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS, SUCCESS STORIES 3. TRAINING 4. DATA SHARING POLICIES 5. ON-LINE/IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO INFORMATION, AND 6. BEING PROACTIVE WITH THE LEGISLATURE.
