- Shared data parcels schema, use local government data model or use statewide data model?
- ESRI User Conference – ArcPro Driven (still lots of crashes), has close to 80% of the tools of ArcMap. Update to ArcPro 2.0 allows to update annotation easier but needs to upgrade to 10.5, but can never edit back in ArcMap. ArcPro 2.0/10.5 attachments can also link to paths instead of storing images internally.
